BUTCHERS CAPSULE originates from the Greek word Hasapikos, meaning "the dance of the butchers", a choreography that reactivates archaic and forgotten ritual gestures. Gloria Dorliguzzo transforms the body into memory, evoking a dance devoid of blood or violence yet imbued with rhythm and ritual. BARRANI - THE DOUBLE ABSENCE

emerges as a sound-based research that transforms into a performance and a music production, unfolding in a field of echoes, reverberations, and words. It evokes a presence "always in the wrong place," the a-topos condition described by Said and Sayad, which marks the migratory experience: a double absence between origin and arrival. In Tunisian, barrani means "foreigner," someone coming from outside and embarking on the journey to Europe. Nostalgia, exile, mother tongue and memory become both refuge and bodily archive in this performative research dedicated to the diaspora generation.

SILENCE DU COEUR begins with a group of young migrants arriving in a Sicilian village at the foot of Mount Etna. Inspired by the novel by Mohamed Mbougar Sarr, the text becomes a mythical and collective fresco, where voices intertwine across languages, traumas and desires. Marie-Aurore d'Awans and Eva Maria Bertschy explore the power of theater as a tool for political and social transformation, capable of shaping listening, justice and collective memory. With the voices of actors Bandiougou Diawara and Daniela Macaluso, the reading and conversation merge into a shared gesture that opens spaces of hospitality and reflection, where the stage becomes a living site of resistance and imagination.
